

## Whiston Hospital Liverpool

The £340M redevelopment of Whiston Hospital in Merseyside required safe and effective access to all facades including the 9 internal courtyards'.

ALPS were chosen to provide an Engineered Suspended Access Solution comprising a series of modular access platforms equipped with powered hoists and safety devices.



14M platform

Each platform could be quickly assembled in each courtyard and relocated to the next location with minimum disruption to the site.

Up to 14 suspended access platforms were supplied each capable of being assembled from 2M up to 18M in length to suit the required locations.

All Temporary Suspended Platforms were suspended from ALPS mobile roof beams.

To ensure maximum safety on site ALPS also supplied specialist site operatives to carry out the initial installation, platform relocation & re-configurations, essential daily pre-use safety checks, preventative maintenance tasks & user's supervision.
